



Provides emergency assistance for medical needs:

- Dental emergencies
- Diabetic supplies
- Durable medical equipment
- Prescriptions (no controlled substances)
- Vision Care

What qualifies as emergency medical assistance?

- Clients must have a pressing need for emergency medical assistance, voucher expires 14 days from date provided. One date of service per year. Maximum of three dates of service. Not eligible for assistance for 24 months following third date of service.
- The program does NOT cover Medicare/Medicaid co-pays, emergency room visits, pre-existing medical expenses, routine doctor's visits and hospitalization.

Who qualifies? For additional information, please call United Way 2-1-1.

Income guideline for each household is 200% of federal poverty level.

- Example: Single person with income of less than \$1,817/month.
- Applicants must provide: Picture IDs, Social Security cards, proof of income for everyone in household and proof of address for past 30 days.
