



### **Provides emergency assistance for medical needs:**

- Dental emergencies: includes dentures
- Diabetic supplies
- Durable medical equipment: includes hearing aids
- Prescriptions (no controlled substances)
- Vision Care

### **What qualifies as emergency medical assistance?**

Clients must have a pressing need for emergency medical assistance, **one time per year**. The program does NOT cover Medicare/Medicaid co-pays, emergency room visits, pre-existing medical expenses, routine doctor's visits and hospitalization.

### **Who qualifies?**

Income guideline for each household is 200% of federal poverty level.

- Example: Single person with income of less than \$1733/month.
- Applicants must provide: Picture IDs, Social Security cards, proof of income for everyone in household and proof of address for past 30 days.
